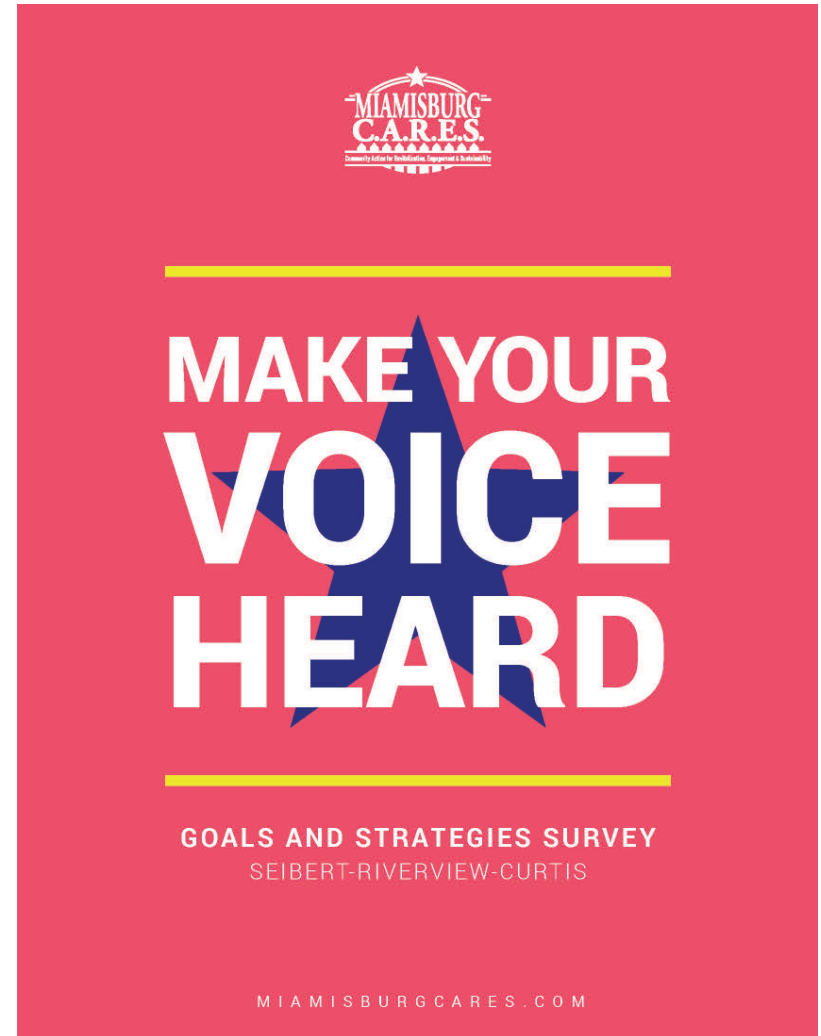

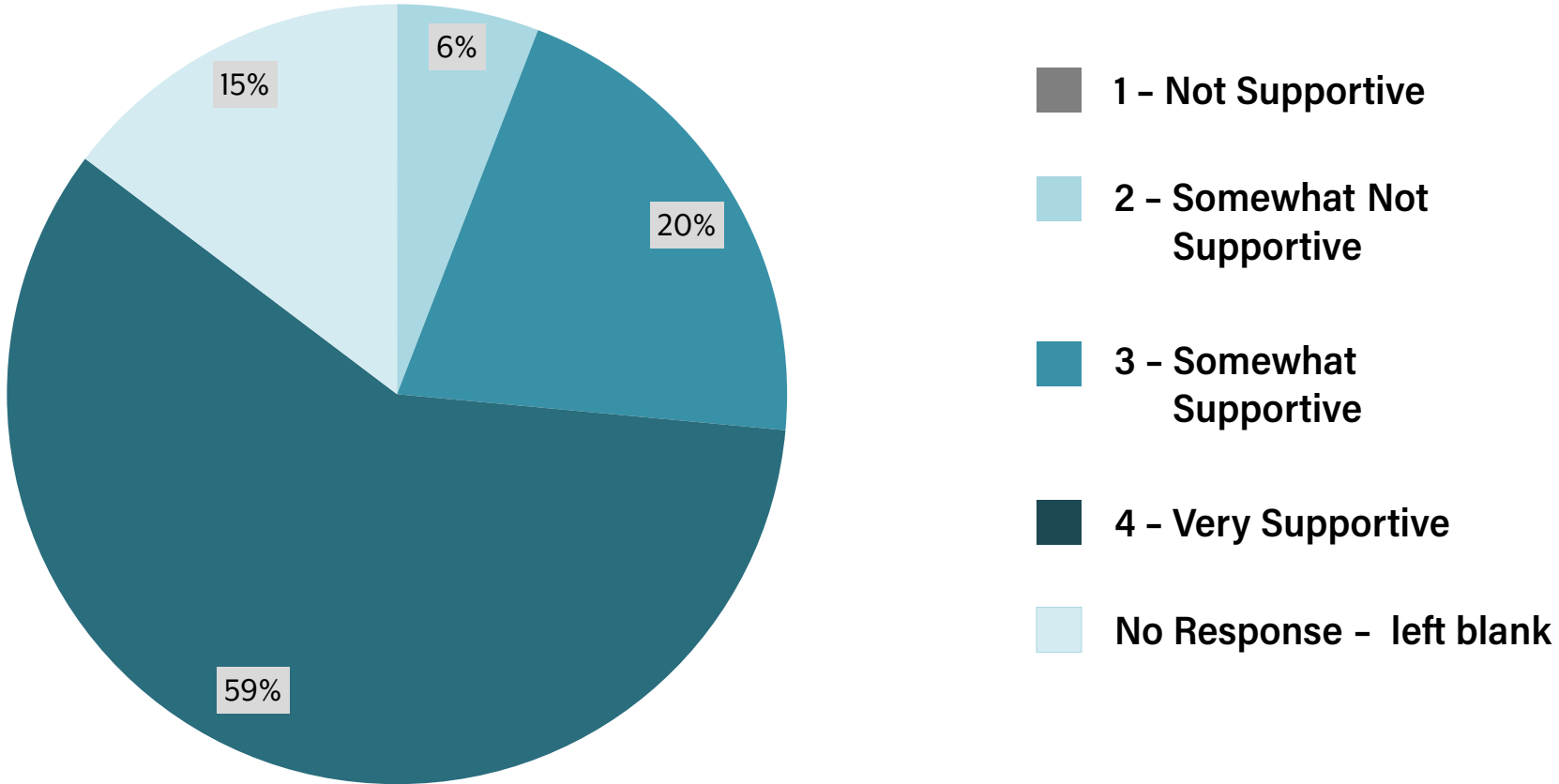

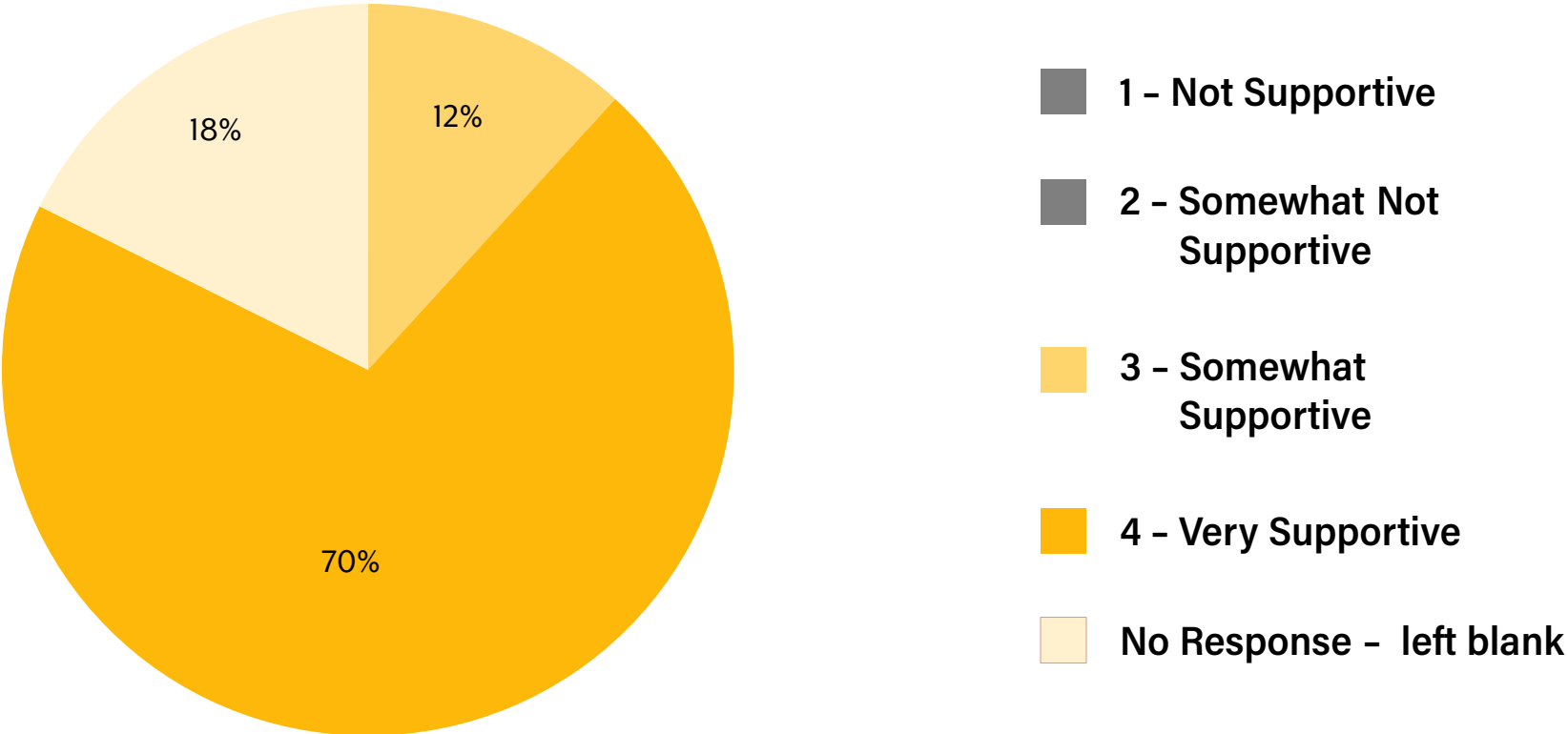
On a scale from 1-4, with **1** being “not supportive” and **4** being “very supportive” please indicate how supportive you are of each goal:



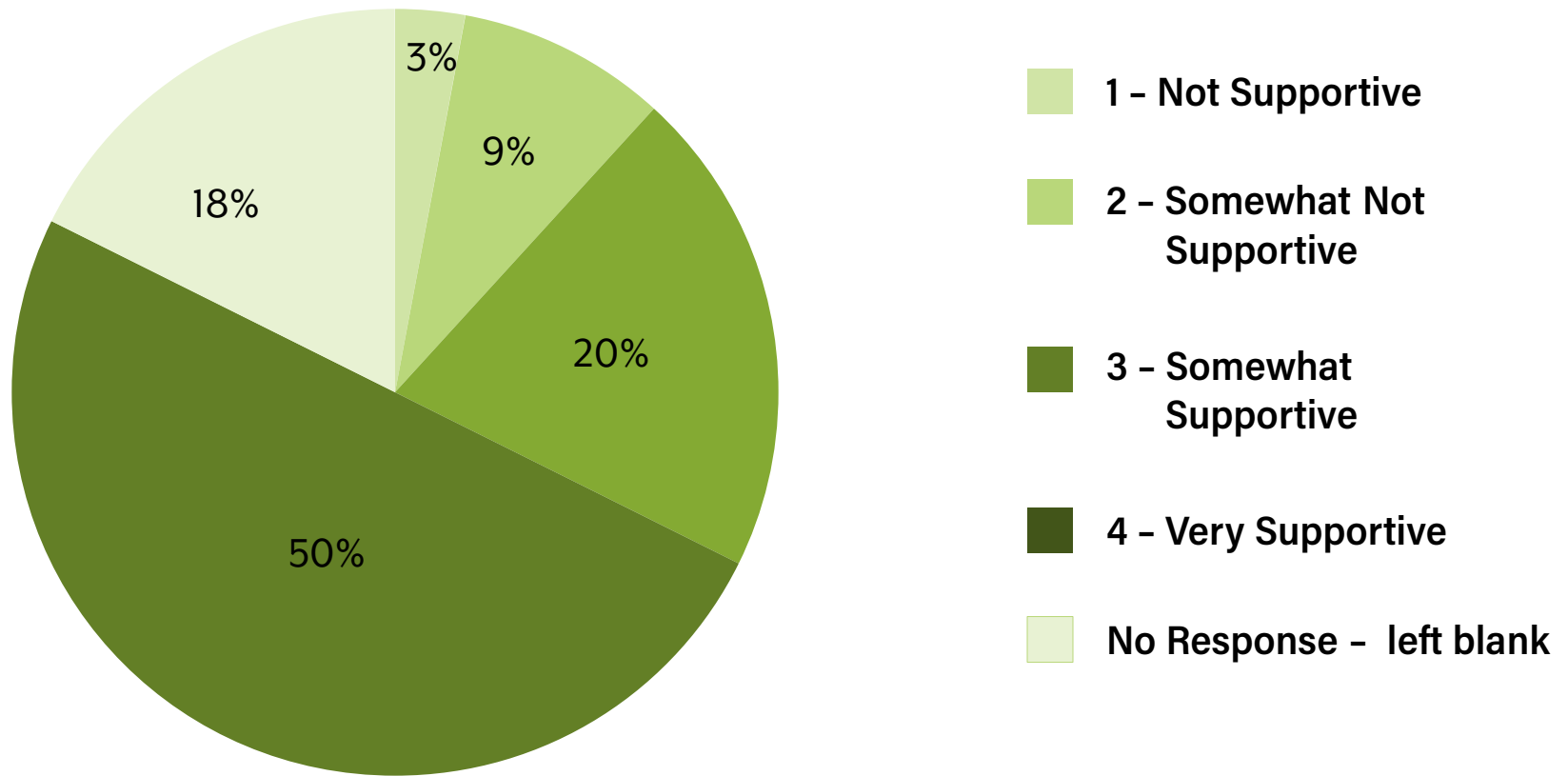

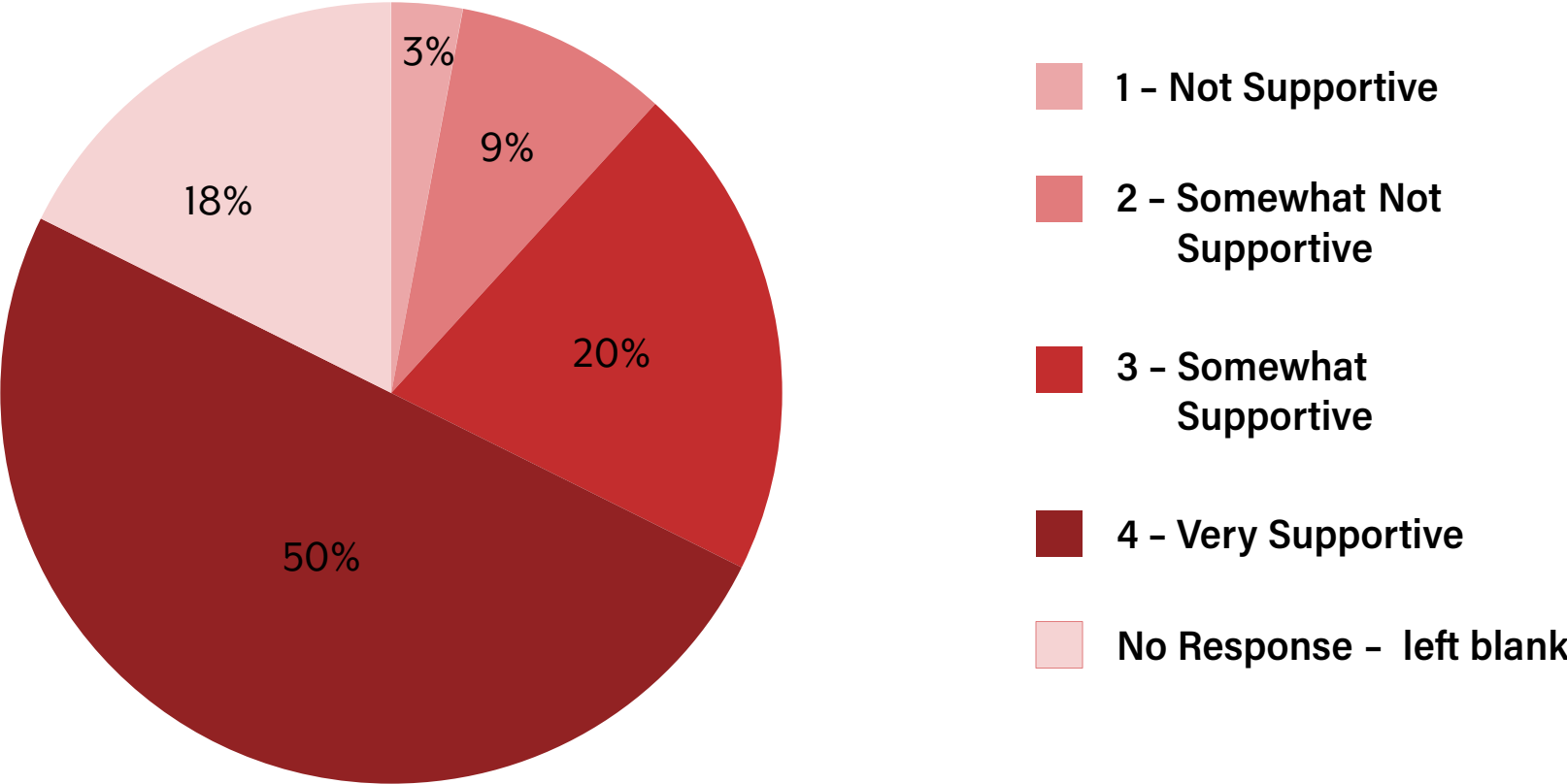

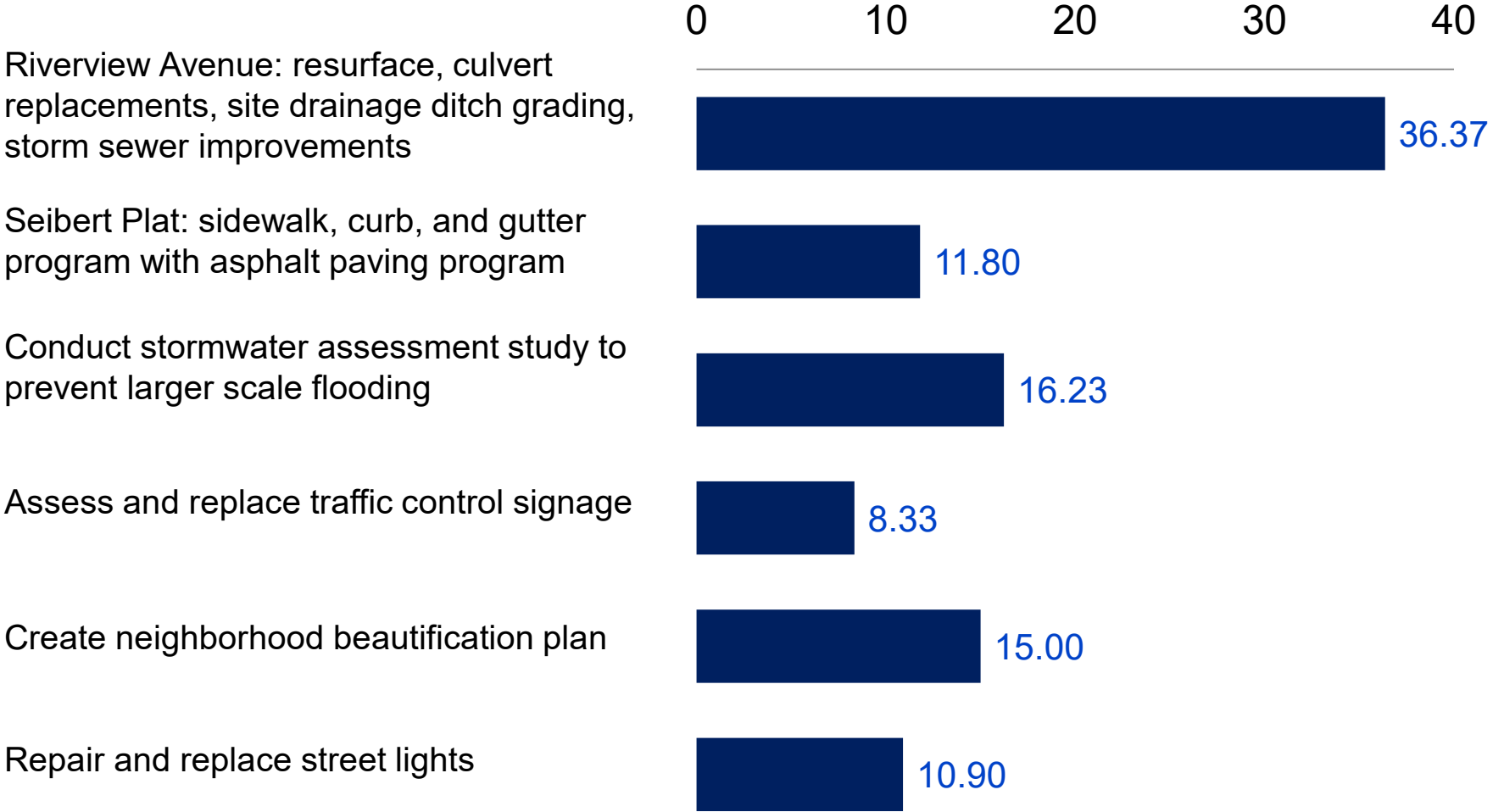

Just fix the streets sewer drains no sidewalks

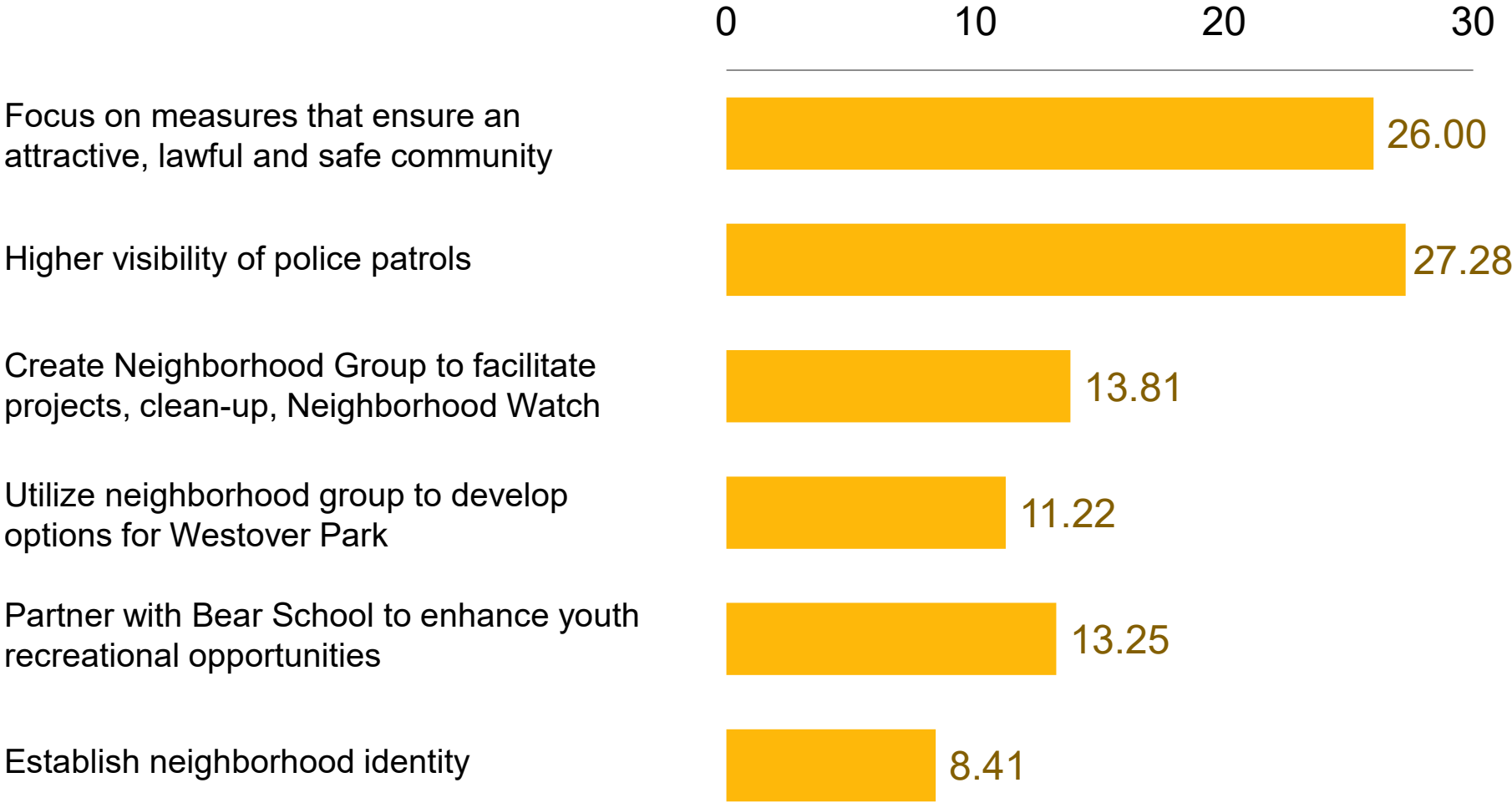
Please make sure to address to flooding problems within Seibert plat. Storm runoff is terrible!

Go after the drug dealers homes

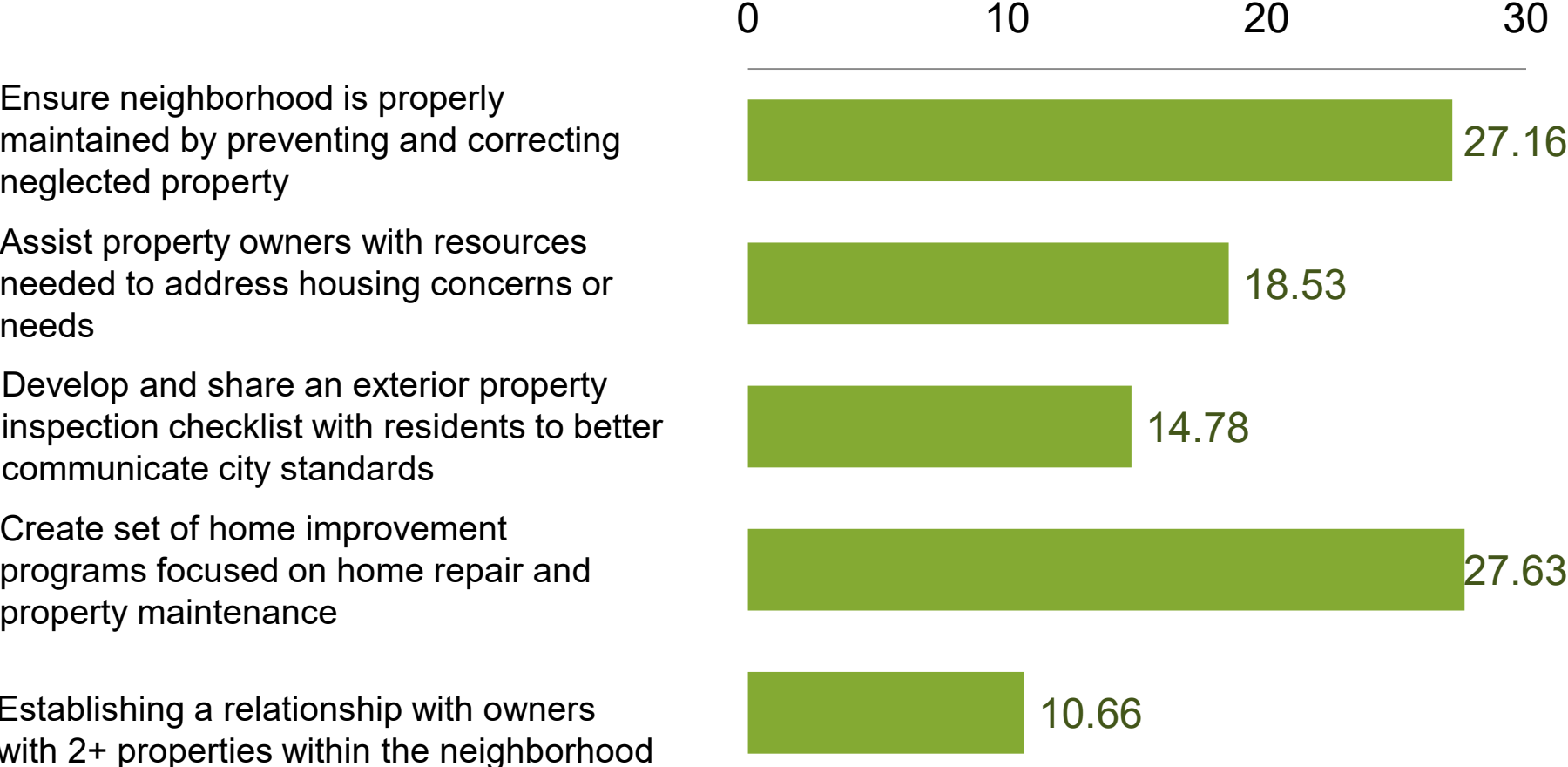
Fix the side walks.

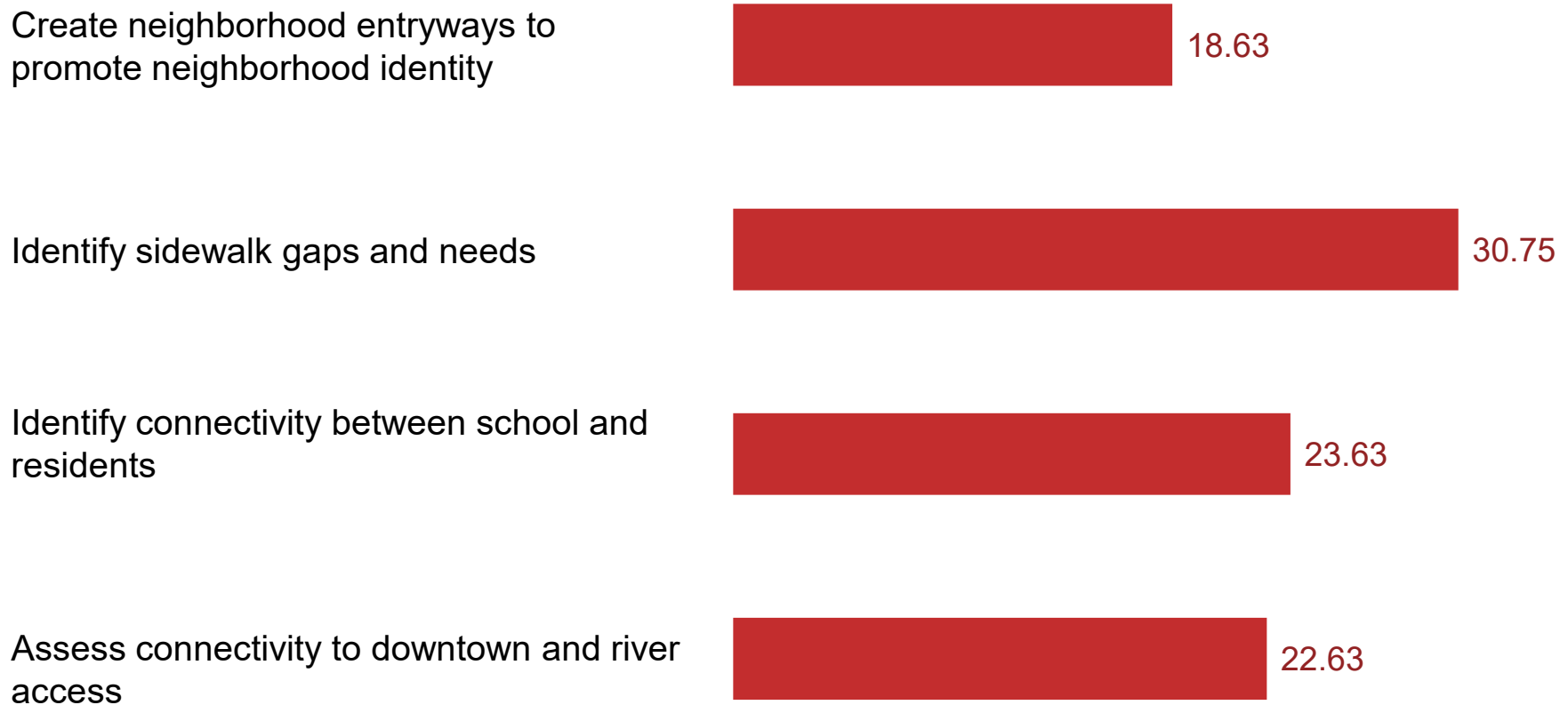
There are junk cars
